It literally means to cause saliva to flow (fluir) in someone's mouth.</p>



Especially Spelling

Especially-especialmente. **Especially** is used to say that something applies more to one thing than to others.

Example:

We should practice more, especially grammar.

Specially-especificamente, expresamente.

Specially is used to say that something is done for a particular purpose.

Example:

This mouse is specially designed for left-handed people.

Sears Roebuck Catalog Tidbit

Richard Sears and Alvah Roebuck

founded Sears and Roebuck Co in the 19th century. The first store's catalog was published in 1888 and allowed farmers, who used to buy their supplies from local general stores (often at very high prices) to know what they were buying and at what price. The catalog soon started featuring sewing machines, bicycles, refrigerators and even clothes.
